The truck driver will provide you with a Bill Of Lading (BOL) or a Delivery Receipt (DR).

Carefully inspect your freight BEFORE you sign the BOL/DR.

Red Flags to Look For When Inspecting Your Freight

- Tears in shrink-wrap
- · Different colored shrink-wrap
- Loose items not wrapped on a pallets / skids
- · Broken wooden pallets (AKA skids)
- Broken / missing banding
- More / less# of pallets / skids than listed on the BOL / DR

What To Do If There Are Damaged / Missing Items

- Be sure to make clear and legible notes of ANY issues, damage or discrepencies on the BOL/ DR. You can write this information anywhere on the BOL/DR.
- · Take photos of your freight delivery in the condition it was received.
- · Inform the EverBlock team right away with any issues.
